Manatee County Animal Ordinance Reminder

Residents, renters, and/or guests of Trailer Estates with a dog please review the following:

According to ordinance 22-16, no dog shall be "at large," upon any public property, street, or sidewalk, or on private property of another, without the consent of the property owner. Additionally, the owner or custodian of a dog must have "direct control" of such animal at all times.

The following definitions are related to this section of the ordinance to assist with understanding specific meanings:

AT LARGE shall mean any dog on the owner's premises, not in the control of the owner or custodian; or any dog off the premises of the owner or custodian and not under the physical control of the owner or custodian.

DIRECT CONTROL shall mean immediate and continuous control of an animal at all times by means such as a fence, animal carrier or cage, leash, tether, cord, or chain of sufficient strength to restrain the animal or the animal shall be within the unobstructed sight, attended, and supervised by a competent person, by use of hand or voice control, when on the property of the owner or custodian, or property which the owner or custodian of the animal has the right to use.

Recycle Information

We are having the wrong items being placed in the recycling containers. Only the following items are accepted: paper products, cardboard, aluminum & tin cans, glass, and plastic with the symbol; however, we DO NOT accept plastic grocery store bags. Please put all other items in the solid waste dumpster. Never place items above the rim of the dumpster nor on the ground around the dumpster. Violators may be charged the cost to have the maintenance department correct the program.

MORE RECYCLE NEWS:

Motor oils can be recycled at Auto Zone, and other retail automotive stores. Batteries can be recycled at Batteries Plus. Propane tanks can be recycled at Detweilers, there is no charge. **DO NOT**

PUT THESE ITEMS IN DUMPSTERS!

YARD WASTE INFORMATION: Only brush, trees and grass (no sod) may be put in the yard waste dumpster. All other material goes in solid waste dumpster.

SOLID WASTE INFORMATION:

Solid waste dumpster is for general trash and debris. **NO FLAM-ABLES, OILS, BATTERIES, CHEMICALS OR PROPANE TANKS AL-LOWED**. These items can be recycled quarterly at Manatee County recycle locations at no charge. Watch your water bill for times and locations. **TV, AIRCONDITIONERS, LARGE APPLIANCES**, please call Waste Pro at 941-355-9600 for pick up.

Welcome back to our Northern friends. Hopefully you all had a safe trip and didn't have much damage to your trailer.

Thanks, Residents,

A big thanks to all of you for taking care of your properties with the two hurricanes that hit us and the work you have done to clean up debris at your home. Also, a big thanks for helping your fellow residents and the park staff with clean up.

PARK APPEARANCE

The park is looking good and the care you have taken of your properties is greatly appreciated.

HURRICANE SEASON IS OVER

Hurricane season is finally over and hopefully all of our activities will be back to normal and we can start socializing again.

POLITICAL SIGNS AND BANNERS

Remember that political signs, banners, and flags can only be up for 30 days after the election. They must be removed no later than December 5.

STORM RELATED REPAIRS

The board approved the suspension of violations, because of storm related damages, for 6 months.

You will still need to apply for an ARC permit to make repairs. Work can start on repairs before an ARC permit is received, but you still need to get a permit. The county has waved permit fees for certain building permits that are related to storm damages. Check with the Manatee County Building permit department at: <u>https://www.mymanatee.org/departments/building_development_services/building_permits</u>.

Your contractor should be able to take care of getting the necessary permits. Make sure the contractor you are using is licensed.

If you play Bingo at TE, please read... Bingo games are played Sundays and Wednesdays with Bingo

Bingo games are played Sundays and Wednesdays with Bingo cards being sold from about 5:45PM until 6:45PM. Play starts as soon as the volunteers are ready; usually, by 7:00PM. This is an enjoyable evening for residents and their registered guest who wish to have an evening playing Bingo. Detailed rules are available at Bingo and on our website: trailerestates.com/Governance/Policies & Procedures/PP15A.

A few people have commented they don't feel the need to show their resident and/or guest ID cards to play Bingo. This rule was made by the Board of Trustees, not the Bingo volunteers. Please keep this in mind and act civilly when interacting with the Bingo volunteers. We should all thank the Bingo volunteers and make their job as pleasant as possible. They are valued resident volunteers who donate two (2) nights a week to allow all of us to enjoy Bingo; many have volunteered for years. If anyone would care to help run Bingo, the current volunteers would gladly take a break and welcome the help.

From the Desk of the Health & Welfare Trustee

My heart has been with the community during both storms and I so wish I could make everything ok. The resilience of Florida Residents is being seen every day and Florida Strong is a real thing. Remember what the Red Cross suggests: When we experience a disaster or other stressful life event, we can have a variety of reactions, all of which can be common responses to difficult situations.

- These reactions can include:
- Feeling physically and mentally drained
- Having difficulty making decisions or staying focused on topics
- · Becoming easily frustrated on a more frequent basis
- Arguing more with family and friends
- · Feeling tired, sad, numb, lonely, or worried
- Experiencing changes in appetite or sleep patterns

Most of these reactions are temporary and will go away over time. Try to accept whatever reactions you may have. Look for ways to take one step at a time and focus on taking care of your disaster-related needs and those of your family.

Recovery Takes Time

Getting ourselves and our lives back in a routine that is comfortable for us takes time.


- Take care of your safety. Find a safe place to stay and make sure your physical health needs and those of your family are addressed. Seek medical attention if necessary.
- Limit your exposure to the sights and sounds of disaster, especially on television, the radio and in the newspapers.
- Eat healthy. During times of stress, it is important that you maintain a balanced diet and drink plenty of water.
- Get some rest. With so much to do, it may be difficult to have enough time to rest or get adequate sleep. Giving your body and mind a break can boost your ability to cope with the stress you may be experiencing.
- Stay connected with family and friends. Giving and getting support is one of the most important things you can do. Try to do something as a family that you have all enjoyed in the past.
- Be patient with yourself and with those around you. Recognize that everyone is stressed and may need some time to put their feelings and thoughts in order. That includes you!
- Set priorities. Tackle tasks in small steps.
- Gather information about assistance and resources that will help you and your family members meet your disaster-related needs.
- Stay positive. Remind yourself of how you've successfully gotten through difficult times in the past. Reach out when you need support and help others when they need it.

We all know that December will be different in the Park this year. Someone might be struggling more than you know, so remember that when you're with other residents. We are Florida Strong.



DEMOLITION SERVICES

TRAILER ESTATES ARC PERMITS (PP33)

ARC APPROVAL for HURRICANE RELATED REPAIRS & REPLACE-MENT. You DO need to complete and submit the ARC form PP33, but you DON'T need to wait for approval to do the work.

Manatee County Building Permits – some fees are being waived

To help Manatee County residents, Development Services is waiving residential and commercial property building permit fees through December 31, 2024, for standard door and window replacement (size for size), standard roof replacement, standard electrical (minor electrical repairs) and standard residential (alteration for interior repair from water intrusion). Substantial Damage Review is required if the structure is located within a flood zone. A permit will not be required for drywall repair if the structure is located outside a flood zone. However, a permit may be required based on scope of work.

Manatee County residents can also call the Building and Permitting Department at (941) 748-4501, ext. 3800, to check if their contractor is registered locally, review any complaints against them, or access their permit history.

Mental Health Hotline - Call or text the Disaster Distress Helpline at 1-800-985-5990. The national hotline provides free 24/7, crisis counseling for people experiencing emotional distress related to any natural or human-caused disaster. Deaf and hard-of-hearing ASL callers can call using your preferred Relay provider.

More Time to File and Pay Your Taxes

Currently, taxpayers in the entire states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina, and parts of Tennessee and Virginia, who received extensions to file their 2023 returns have until May 1, 2025, to file. Tax-year 2023 tax payments are not eligible for this extension. In addition, May 1 is also the deadline for filing 2024 returns and paying any tax due. IR-2024-266, Oct. 11, 2024 (irs.gov)

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Marina News

The marina is very limited on longer size slips. If you are going to buy a boat that is over 19 feet long, **please**, call the dock master to see if we have a slip available. The Dock master has had to disappoint several people by telling them we had no place for them to dock their new boat.

Boats will only be rented slips that they fit in. For instance, if you have a boat that fits in a 28 foot slip, you will not be able to rent a 30 ft slip, if your boat fits in a 22ft slip, you will not able to rent a 26ftslip. The larger slips are for longer boats. Boats are measured from the farthest thing that sticks out on the bow to the motor in full tilt. We do not measure your boat by what it says on the registration.

If you are buying a party boat, deck boat or pontoon boat, please watch the size of the beam (width) of the boat you buy. These newer, wider boats have a hard time fitting in many of the slips without touching the sides of the decking. Please buy a boat that will give you room, on each side, to adjust with the ebb and flow of the tide.

From Old to New: Fob to FOB-ID

If you're in the Park and have not visited the office for your new FOB-ID, please do so during regular office hours. Please bring your old Fob and your valid TE ID (green for owners and yellow for renters) to be turned in to receive your new FOB-ID. If you don't have a valid TE ID, please bring your driver's license. If you're not in the Park, your old Fob won't work and the office is closed on the weekends, so plan your return accordingly.

REMINDER: If you are an owner with a renter at your property, the renter(s) CAN NOT use your FOB-ID, they must register at the office, and if not already purchased, purchase their own FOB-ID.

NOTE: Do not leave your FOB-ID exposed to the summer heat, it could warp the plastic and render it inoperable. If your FOB-ID gets damaged (or lost) a replacement costs \$50.

Table Reservation Etiquette

If you need banquet tables, card tables, or folding chairs you must reserve them. You can do this by visiting the office or calling to make your request. We allow no more than 3 banquet tables, 6 card tables, and/or 30 chairs per household, per event. We suggest reserving them one week prior to the date you need them because availability is limited and reservations are on a first-come basis. NOTE: The tables and chairs under the stage in the large hall are off limits.

Estoppel Program for Trailer Estates PP-27C

Estoppel Program Cost to Process: \$100 per Estoppel (Payable to Trailer Estates)

Any person who Sells/Purchases/Makes a Title Transfer of Property within Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District must submit an Estoppel Request to the main office. This is done by the Title Company or attorney who is handling the closing. Private sales or Transfer of Title (Quit Claim) must still submit the estoppel request even if not using a title company or Attorney.

In addition, a written application from each prospective purchaser must be submitted and approved BEFORE the sale or transfer.

12. In order to maintain a community of congenial residents who are agreeable to abide by the "housing for older persons" restrictions contained in the Deed Restrictions and provisions of the Charter of Trailer Estates Park and Recreation District (hereinafter collectively "Restrictions"), the transfer of lots or parcels by any owner shall be subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth as long as said Restrictions shall remain in force and effect: It shall be necessary for the Board of Trustees of the Trailer Estates Park and Recreation District, or its duly authorized officers, agents or committee, to approve in writing all sales, transfer of title, leases or subleases of a lot or parcel, or occupation of a dwelling unit on a lot or parcel, before such sale, transfer, lease, sublease or occupation shall be valid and effective. Written application for such approval shall contain such information as may be reasonably required by application forms promulgated by the board of Trustees and shall be accompanied by a transfer fee as required by resolution of the Board, provided; however, such fee shall not exceed Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

Trailer Estates will perform the following actions:

- Advise any Fines or Service Fees charged to Property by Trailer Estates.
- 2. Advise any outstanding Violations.
- Require appropriate Application(s) to be filled out and completed, along with Application Fee to Live/Own/Rent Property in Trailer Estates prior to closing.
- Age Verification & ID check (copy of Driver's License or State ID, Birth Certificate, ETC.
- 5. We will Disclose the Annual Assessment Cost + Any Special Assessment(s) that are in place.
- 6. Advise that Trailer Estates is not a Pet Friendly Community (except 46 Specific Homes).

If the Estoppel process is not followed by anyone who Sells/Purchases/Makes a Title Transfer of Property within Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District, they may be subject to Fines & Suspensions under Part E of the Rules & Regulations.

Public Notice Warning

According to Florida Law, consumers who knowingly hire unlicensed construction contractors could face a fine of up to \$5,000. Chapter 455-228 of the Florida Statutes allows the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) to impose a civil penalty of \$500 to \$5,000 on individuals who aid and abet unlicensed contractors. Receiving Mail & Parcels at Trailer Estates

Attention New Residents (and long-timers, too):

To ensure you receive mail, please use your TE Post Office Box Number (or another PO Box outside of TE). If you give your TE physical address as a mailing address, you will not receive your mail. Use your physical address for the delivery of parcels and/ or large items like furniture and appliances. Additionally, please check that the address listed with the Manatee County Property Appraiser is an address other than your TE physical address. The Importance of Accident and Incident Reporting

The Policy and Procedure #27B- Accident and Incident Reporting policy was adopted in 2022, and copies are available next to the first aid boxes. To quote from the policy, "If an accident or incident occurs on District property, it is critical to gather information and document the event for reporting purposes. An accident or incident is defined as any event that leads to a personal injury to a resident, guest, or visitor." This policy depends on everyone to do the right thing by reporting any accident or incident, whether you are a witness or directly involved in the event. EMS is to be called for every accident or incident occurring on District property.

Now you are probably thinking, "What do I do if I witness someone who has been injured?" We ask everyone to complete the Accident and Incident Reporting form and gather as much information as possible. Even if you did not witness the accident/incident, but come upon an individual who has been involved in an accident or appears injured, the information you provide on the form is vital. Completing this document does not hold you responsible. Once the Accident and Incident Reporting form is completed, please drop it by the office, or in the night drop box, if the office is closed. This information is shared with the District's liability carrier.

What makes Trailer Estates unique as a 55+ community is its long history of caring for each other. We ask that every resident familiarize yourself with this Policy and Procedure and act on it if you become involved in or witness an accident or incident.

Our Proposal to Change How Trailer Estates Votes On Deed Restrictions

Why would TE want to Change the Deed Restrictions?

Deed Restrictions are rules that govern how property can be used and maintained within a certain area. Over time, these restrictions might need updating for several reasons:

- 1. <u>Changing Legal Standards</u>: Laws and regulations evolve. What was acceptable or legal when the deed restrictions were first written may no longer comply with current legal standards, such as fair housing laws or environmental regulations.
- 2. <u>Shifts in Community Needs</u>: As communities grow and change, their needs and priorities often shift. Updating deed restrictions can help address new community concerns, such as increased demand for investor properties or short-term rentals.
- Modernization: Older deed restrictions might be outdated or overly restrictive given contemporary lifestyles and technologies. For example, restrictions that prohibit solar panels or satellite dishes might need to be revised to accommodate modern amenities.
- 4. <u>Consistency and Clarity</u>: Over time, changes in property ownership or management can lead to inconsistencies in how deed restrictions are enforced. Updating them can ensure that all residents have a clear understanding of the rules and that they are applied consistently.
- 5. <u>Addressing Enforcement Issues</u>: Sometimes, restrictions may become difficult to enforce due to changes in circumstances or the way they are written. Updating them can help streamline enforcement and address practical issues.
- 6. <u>Maintaining Property Values</u>: Ensuring that deed restrictions are relevant and reasonable can help maintain or even increase property values by keeping the community attractive and well-maintained.
- 7. <u>Resolving Conflicts</u>: As issues arise within a community, updated restrictions can provide clearer guidelines and resolutions to disputes that may have surfaced over time.
- 8. Overall, regularly reviewing and updating deed restrictions helps to ensure that they continue to serve the best interests of the community and adapt to changing circumstances.

Why is this Change Needed?

Having residents vote on changes to deed restrictions is important for several reasons:

<u>Democratic Process</u>: Voting ensures that all property owners have a say in decisions that affect their community. This democratic process helps maintain fairness and transparency in how changes are implemented. <u>Community Consensus</u>: Deed restrictions often impact everyone within a community. A vote helps gauge the level of consensus or opposition to proposed changes, ensuring that any modifications reflect the collective interests of the residents.

Engagement and Buy-In: Allowing residents to vote, fosters a sense of ownership and involvement in the community. When people have a direct role in decision-making, they are more likely to support and adhere to the updated rules.

Legal Requirements: Many governing documents, such as homeowners' association (HOA) bylaws or subdivision agreements, may require a vote for amendments to deed restrictions. Following these procedures helps ensure that changes are legally valid and enforceable.

<u>Conflict Resolution</u>: Voting can help address and resolve disagreements among residents about proposed changes. It provides a structured way to address differing opinions and come to a collective decision.

<u>Transparency</u>: A voting process makes the decision-making process more transparent and accountable, reducing the risk of disputes or claims of unfairness in how changes are made.



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Architectural Review Committee

ARC APPROVAL for HURRICANE RELATED REPAIRS & REPLACEMENT

You DO need to complete and submit the ARC form PP33, but you DO NOT need to wait for approval to do the work.

If you make any changes to the outside of your home that ARE NOT related to hurricane damage, you must first obtain an ARC approval. This approval is needed for repairs and/or new work such as doors, windows, stairs, paver, A/C, sheds, fencing, etc. Prior to beginning any work, you need to complete and submit a Deed Restrictions Building Request (PP33). You can get this form at the TE office or on the TE website. The ARC will review your completed request and notify you of the approval/denial. Please note that for some work, a lot survey MAY BE REQUIRED.

Upon approval, an orange card will be issued and must be displayed in your window for six months or until the project is completed, whichever comes first. All permits will expire six months from the date of issue. The ARC has up to thirty days to act on your request. If you are submitting a PP33 for any fence installation on your property, you MUST provide a site/lot survey. These surveys let you (and your neighbor) know exactly where the lot lines are located and are there for your protection when you install your fence.

A Message from the Art Club:



Our first breakfast will be January 13, 2025, tickets go on sale







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Holiday Recipes

PEAR & GINGER SPRITZ

2 oz. of gin 2 oz. of pear & ginger syrup 1 oz. of fresh lemon juice 1 piece of ginger Sparkling wine

HOLIDAY TURKEY BURGERS

Ingredients

1 lb. lean ground turkey breast

2 tbsp breadcrumbs

1 egg, large

2 tbsp shallot, cut into small dice

1 ½ tsp. Dijon mustard

1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce

¹/₄ tsp. salt

¹/₂ tsp. freshly ground pepper

1 tbsp fresh parsley or 1 tsp. dried tsp. dried red pepper flakes

tsp. dried red p

Olive oil

Sliced soft cheese of your choice (1 slice per burger) 4-6 brioche buns sliced and toasted under the broiler

just before serving

2 tsp. dijon mustard for serving

Cranberry sauce, homemade or store-bought

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350° and prepare a baking sheet lined with parchment paper.

Place ground turkey, breadcrumbs, egg, shallot, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper, parsley, and dried red pepper flakes in a large bowl. With clean hands, mix gently until everything is combined.

Form into 4-6 patties.

Heat a 9 or 10" skillet on medium heat with enough olive oil to lightly cover the bottom of the pan, add the four patties (but don't crowd them) and cook for about 2 minutes per side until lightly browned, turning once.

Remove from skillet and place on the prepared baking sheet.

Bake the patties for 9 minutes, then remove from the oven and divide the cheese onto each patty.

Place the baking tray back in the oven and continue to bake for about 3-4 more minutes, until the cheese is melted.

Toast the hamburger buns under the broiler, then divide the mustard and cranberry sauce on the buns, top with the turkey patty, and garnish with "greens" of your choice.

MINTY HOLIDAY BLONDIES

1 cup salted butter, at room temperature,

plus more for greasing pan

- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup white chocolate chips
- 1 cup coarsely crushed peppermint candies (about 40 candies), divided

lcing:

2 cups powdered sugar 1/4 cup salted butter, at room temperature 1 tsp. vanilla extract 1/4 tsp. peppermint extract

2 to 3 Tbsp. heavy cream

Directions

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease a 13- x 9-inch baking pan with butter. Line pan with parchment paper, allowing paper to extend over edges of pan. Grease paper.

Prepare the Blondies batter:

Combine butter and granulated sugar in a large bowl. Beat with an electric mixer on medium speed until pale and fluffy, about 3 minutes. Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating until combined after each addition. Beat in vanilla and salt. Add flour; beat on low speed just until combined, 1 to 2 minutes. Stir in white chocolate chips and 1/2 cup of the crushed peppermints, reserving remaining crushed peppermints. (Batter will be thick.)

Bake Blondies:

Spoon batter in prepared pan; spread in even layer with a small offset spatula. Bake in preheated oven until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean, 20 to 22 minutes. Cool completely in pan, about 1 hour. Lift blondies from pan using parchment paper as handles. Remove and discard paper; trim browned edges. Prepare the lcing:

Combine powdered sugar, butter, vanilla, and peppermint extract in a medium bowl; beat on medium speed until well combined, about 2 minutes. Beat in 2 tablespoons of the cream. Add up to 1 additional tablespoon cream, if necessary, until icing reaches a spreadable consistency, about 1 minute. Spread Icing over top of blondies. Sprinkle with reserved crushed peppermints. Cut and serve.
