Notes from the Park Manager

Deed Restrictions and District rules can be a double-edged sword. On one hand, they help maintain neighborhood standards and property values. On the other hand, navigating the rules and regulations can sometimes feel like walking through a minefield. We get it!

Here's How to Avoid Getting a Violation:

A significant portion of the violations we write are from property maintenance issues such as:

- Overgrown lawns, un-trimmed hedges and bushes, weeds in gravel or shell, peeling paint, or a general unkempt property
- Ensure that the exterior of your home is well-maintained, including power washing away mold and mildew from siding, awnings, and roofing.
- Properly store items like recreational vehicles and boats. Do not use your driveway or carport for open storage.
- Get ARC Approvals before making any changes to the outside of your property; complete and submit any required forms for approval before beginning work.

If you get a violation - take corrective action, address the issue as quickly as possible, whether that means repairing your property, mowing the grass, removing weeds, etc. If you are not sure about something or are having a scheduling problem getting the work done- Call us! We are here to help. This summer we have had a lot of rain – make sure you have someone inspect and maintain your property if you are not a year-round resident.

Please, do not ignore violations! They will not go away magically! Violations if not satisfied, can lead to fines of up to \$1000. These fines can accumulate if the violation is not addressed promptly. With warm regards,

If So, This Friendly Reminder Is For You...

- Whenever you get a new boat (vessel) registration, we need a copy of it at the office.
- Whenever you get a new registration for the trailer in your storage lot, we also need a copy of that.
- Finally, whenever you renew your insurance for the items above, we need a copy of that renewal, as well.

Marina News

The marina is very limited on longer size slips. If you are going to buy a boat that is over 19 feet long, **please**, call the dock master to see if we have a slip available. The Dock master has had to disappoint several people by telling them we had no place for them to dock their new boat.

Boats will only be rented slips that they fit in. For instance, if you have a boat that fits in a 28 foot slip, you will not be able to rent a 30 ft slip, if your boat fits in a 22ft slip, you will not able to rent a 26ftslip. The larger slips are for longer boats. Boats are measured from the farthest thing that sticks out on the bow to the motor in full tilt. We do not measure your boat by what it says on the registration.

If you are buying a party boat, deck boat or pontoon boat, please watch the size of the beam (width) of the boat you buy. These newer, wider boats have a hard time fitting in many of the slips without touching the sides of the decking. Please buy a boat that will give you room, on each side, to adjust with the ebb and flow of the tide.

Table Reservation Etiquette

If you need banquet tables, card tables, or folding chairs you must reserve them. You can do this by visiting the office or calling to make your request. We allow no more than 3 banquet tables, 6 card tables, and/or 30 chairs per household, per event. We suggest reserving them one week prior to the date you need them because availability is limited and reservations are on a first-come basis. NOTE: The tables and chairs under the stage in the large hall are off limits.

Receiving Mail & Parcels at Trailer Estates

Attention New Residents (and long-timers, too):

To ensure you receive mail, please use your TE Post Office Box Number (or another PO Box outside of TE). If you give your TE physical address as a mailing address, you will not receive your mail. Use your physical address for the delivery of parcels and/or large items like furniture and appliances. Additionally, please check that the address listed with the Manatee County Property Appraiser is an address other than your TE physical address. You can check the address they have on file by visiting their website: https://www.manateepao.gov/search/.

Public Notice Warning

According to Florida Law, consumers who knowingly hire unlicensed construction contractors could face a fine of up to \$5,000. Chapter 455-228 of the Florida Statutes allows the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) to impose a civil penalty of \$500 to \$5,000 on individuals who aid and abet unlicensed contractors. They may also be liable for court costs.

From Old to New: Fob to FOB-ID

If you're in the Park and have not visited the office for your new FOB-ID, please do so during regular office hours. Please bring your old Fob and your valid TE ID (green for owners and yellow for renters) to be turned in to receive your new FOB-ID. If you don't have a valid TE ID, please bring your driver's license. If you're not in the Park, your old Fob won't work and the office is closed on the weekends, so plan your return accordingly.

REMINDER: If you are an owner with a renter at your property, the renter(s) CAN NOT use your FOB-ID, they must register at the office, and if not already purchased, purchase their own FOB-ID.

NOTE: Do not leave your FOB-ID exposed to the summer heat, it could warp the plastic and render it inoperable. If your FOB-ID gets damaged (or lost) a replacement costs \$50.



Architectural Review Committee (ARC)

August & September Meeting Schedule: 2nd & 4th Tuesdays

If you make any changes to the outside of your home, you must first obtain an ARC approval. This approval is needed for repairs and/or new work such as doors, windows, stairs, paver, A/C, sheds, fencing, etc. Prior to beginning any work, you need to complete and submit a Deed Restrictions Building Request (PP33). You can get this form at the TE office or on the TE website. The ARC will review your completed request and notify you of the approval/denial. Please note that for some work, a lot survey MAY BE REQUIRED.

Upon approval, an orange card will be issued and must be displayed in your window for six months or until the project is completed, whichever comes first. All permits will expire six months from the date of issue. The ARC has up to thirty days to act on your request.

If you are submitting a PP33 for any fence installation on your property, you MUST provide a site/lot survey. These surveys let you (and your neighbor) know exactly where the lot lines are located and are there for your protection when you install your fence.

SUMMER VISITORS

You may have family using your trailer this summer. You need to complete a PP30 (AGREEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR GUEST CARDS) and have your guest come to the office to get a guest FOB-ID.

RV OVERNIGHT PARKING

If summer guests are coming down with an RV, remember that they cannot park for more than 48 hours at a residence without a permit. Permits can be obtained, with proper identification, at the office. No one can occupy an RV overnight at the residence. They can get an overnight permit to park at the Park Lane parking lot. RVs at the Park Lane parking lot must be self-contained units. No generators may be used and no hook-up to any park utilities is permitted. Overnight parking in other TE parking areas or on the TEN property is prohibited. Vehicles SHALL BETOWED AWAY ATTHE OWNER'S EXPENSE. Read the Rules and Regulations for Overnight Parking under the Governance Tab on the Trailer Estates Web Page (trailerestates.com).

HURRICANE SEASON PREPARATION

If you are leaving the park to return home, going on a trip, or evacuating, please remember to put all of your outside items inside. This will ensure that the items will be there when you return and that they have not done any damage to anyone else's property. Also, remember to register with CERT so they are able to contact you in case of emergency or to report any damage to your property. Please read PP 20 Disaster Preparedness Plan.

SUMMER PROPERTY CARE

Make sure your property is properly maintained this summer. With the rainy season coming up, your yard and weeds will need to be taken care of more frequently. There may be downed branches and damage to your buildings, so make sure some one is watching your property.

Recycle Information

We are having the wrong items being placed in the recycling containers. Only the following items are accepted: paper products, cardboard, aluminum & tin cans, glass, and plastic with the symbol; however, we DO NOT accept plastic grocery store bags. Please put all other items in the solid waste dumpster. Never place items above the rim of the dumpster nor on the ground around the dumpster. Violators may be charged the cost to have the maintenance department correct the program.

MORE RECYCLE NEWS:

Motor oils can be recycled at Auto Zone, and other retail automotive stores. Batteries can be recycled at Batteries Plus. Propane tanks can be recycled at Detweilers, there is no charge. **DO NOT PUT THESE ITEMS IN DUMPSTERS!**

YARD WASTE INFORMATION:

Only brush, trees and grass (no sod) may be put in the yard waste dumpster. All other material goes in solid waste dumpster.

SOLID WASTE INFORMATION:

Solid waste dumpster is for general trash and debris. NO FLAM-ABLES, OILS, BATTERIES, CHEMICALS OR PROPANE TANKS AL-**LOWED**. These items can be recycled quarterly at Manatee County recycle locations at no charge. Watch your water bill for times and locations. TV, AIRCONDITIONERS, LARGE APPLIANCES, please call Waste Pro at 941-355-9600 for pick up.

The Importance of Accident and Incident Reporting

The Policy and Procedure #27B- Accident and Incident Reporting policy was adopted in 2022, and copies are available next to the first aid boxes. To quote from the policy, "If an accident or incident occurs on District property, it is critical to gather information and document the event for reporting purposes. An accident or incident is defined as any event that leads to a personal injury to a resident, guest, or visitor." This policy depends on everyone to do the right thing by reporting any accident or incident, whether you are a witness or directly involved in the event. EMS is to be called for every accident or incident occurring on District property.

Now you are probably thinking, "What do I do if I witness someone who has been injured?" We ask everyone to complete the Accident and Incident Reporting form and gather as much information as possible. Even if you did not witness the accident/incident, but come upon an individual who has been involved in an accident or appears injured, the information you provide on the form is vital. Completing this document does not hold you responsible. Once the Accident and Incident Reporting form is completed, please drop it by the office, or in the night drop box, if the office is closed. This information is shared with the District's liability carrier.

What makes Trailer Estates unique as a 55+ community is its long history of caring for each other. We ask that every resident familiarize yourself with this Policy and Procedure and act on it if you become involved in or witness an accident or incident.



Manatee County Animal Ordinance Reminder

Residents, renters, and/or guests of Trailer Estates with a dog please review the following:

According to ordinance 22-16, no dog shall be "at large," upon any public property, street, or sidewalk, or on private property of another, without the consent of the property owner. Additionally, the owner or custodian of a dog must have "direct control" of such animal at all times.

The following definitions are related to this section of the ordinance to assist with understanding specific meanings:

AT LARGE shall mean any dog on the owner's premises, not in the control of the owner or custodian; or any dog off the premises of the owner or custodian and not under the physical control of the owner or custodian.

DIRECT CONTROL shall mean immediate and continuous control of an animal at all times by means such as a fence, animal carrier or cage, leash, tether, cord, or chain of sufficient strength to restrain the animal or the animal shall be within the unobstructed sight, attended, and supervised by a competent person, by use of hand or voice control, when on the property of the owner or custodian, or property which the owner or custodian of the animal has the right to use.

Estoppel Program for

Any person who Sells/Purchases/Makes a Title Transfer of Property within Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District must submit an Estoppel Request to the main office. This is done by the Title Company or attorney who is handling the closing. Private sales or Transfer of Title (Quit Claim) must still submit the estoppel request even if not using a title company or Attorney.

In addition, a written application from each prospective purchaser must be submitted and approved BEFORE the sale or transfer.

12. In order to maintain a community of congenial residents who are agreeable to abide by the "housing for older persons" restrictions contained in the Deed Restrictions and provisions of the Charter of Trailer Estates Park and Recreation District (hereinafter collectively "Restrictions"), the transfer of lots or parcels by any owner shall be subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth as long as said Restrictions shall remain in force and effect: It shall be necessary for the Board of Trustees of the Trailer Estates Park and Recreation District, or its duly authorized officers, agents or committee, to approve in writing all sales, transfer of title, leases or subleases of a lot or parcel, or occupation of a dwelling unit on a lot or parcel, before such sale, transfer, lease, sublease or occupation shall be valid and effective. - 3. Require appropriate Application(s) to be filled out and completed, along with Application Fee to Live/Own/Rent Property in Trailer Estates prior to closing.
- 4. Age Verification & ID check (copy of Driver's License or State ID, Birth Certificate, ETC.
- 5. We will Disclose the Annual Assessment Cost + Any Special Assessment(s) that are in place.
- 6. Advise that Trailer Estates is not a Pet Friendly Community (except 46 Specific Homes).

If the Estoppel process is not followed by anyone who Sells/Purchases/Makes a Title Transfer of Property within Trailer Estates Park & Recreation District, they may be subject to Fines & Suspensions under Part E of the Rules & Regulations.





In addition to our needs in Trailer Estates, newly forming CERT organizations are asking for training in Manatee County and we have been asked to assist by offering a CERT Basic Training Class. Our CERT is answering the call by offering a CERT certification class to be held September 25, 26, 27 and October 2, 3, and 4. The classes begin at 10AM and are finished for the day by 2PM, with many of the classes ending earlier. The classes for our community will be held in Bayshore Gardens Park and Recreation District. You can email the address above or call one of the listed numbers to receive an application.

Your Trailer Estates CERT team is preparing and hope we will not have to use our training. The Communication Center/Command Center is in the Activity Building. In the event of an emergency, and the building is safe, we will be operating from there. If you should need assistance, please come to the Activity Building and we will be there to help during daylight hours. In the event that

the Activity Building is not safe, we will have a CERT member in the vicinity to direct you to our Communication trailer. We can communicate with Manatee County Emergency Management from the Activity Building or our Trailer. If the cell towers are damaged, and in a hurricane that is common, the only way to get help is from Emergency management and we can reach them for you. During an event, your CERT team members will be wearing a bright green vest and will have identification, they will be glad to assist you.

If you have not been certified for CERT, there is a place for you in the event of a disaster. Report to the CERT Communication/Command Center to volunteer your time and talents. If you wish more information regarding volunteers, please ask. The contact information is above.

In October, we will have a short presentation/training at the beginning of our monthly meeting and you are all welcome to join us. If you wish to stay for the training and the meeting, please feel free. We will post a schedule of our trainings on our bulletin board and our Facebook page.

Trailer Estates CERT is always welcoming HAM operators, as that may be the only means of communication in a disaster, should we lose cell or 911 system. CERT will offer classes for Ham licensing test preparation in the fall.



KEY LIME PIE MARTINI

Ingredients:

2 ounces of rum

1 ounce of freshly squeezed key lime juice

1 ounce of simple syrup

A graham cracker rim

(crushed graham crackers for garnish)

Rim a chilled martini glass with crushed graham crackers by dipping the rim in a shallow dish of simple syrup followed by a dish of crushed graham crackers.

Shake vigorously until well-chilled.

Strain the mixture into the prepared martini glass.

Garnish with a small slice of key lime or a twist of lime peel, if desired.

STRAWBERRY COBBLER

Ingredients

2 pounds fresh strawberries hulled and halved (900g)

1 cup granulated sugar divided (200g)

9 tablespoons unsalted butter (120g)

21/4 cup all-purpose flour (270g)

2½ teaspoons baking powder

1¼ cup milk (300ml)

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

½ teaspoon kosher salt

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 350°F.

In a large bowl, stir together the strawberries and 1/2 cup of sugar. Set aside to macerate.

Add the butter to a 13x9-inch baking dish and place in the preheated oven until the butter is melted, about 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, in a medium mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, salt, and remaining 1/2 cup of sugar. Add the milk and vanilla extract and stir just until combined.

Carefully remove the baking dish from the oven and pour the batter over the melted butter. Spoon the strawberries over the batter, leaving any extra liquid in the bottom of the bowl and discarding it.

Bake for 55 to 60 minutes or until the batter is golden brown and the strawberry juices are bubbling. Let cool for 15 minutes. Serve with vanilla ice cream, if desired.

ITALIAN TORTELLINI PASTA SALAD

Ingredients for Pasta Salad

1 lb tortellini

1 large bell pepper

1 small red onion diced

34 cup mixed pitted olives roughly chopped

1 jar marinated artichoke hearts

4 oz salami chopped

½ cup pepperoncini chopped

½ cup chopped fresh parsley

2 oz Parmesan cheese shredded

For the Italian dressing

34 cup olive oil

½ cup red wine vinegar

1 tbsp balsamic vinegar

1 small shallot roughly chopped

2 cloves garlic smashed

34 tsp kosher salt

½ tsp black pepper

1/4 tsp red pepper flakes

2 tsp Dijon mustard

2 tbsp fresh oregano leaves

10 leaves fresh basil

Cook the pasta according to the package instructions. Once the pasta is cooked, remove it from the heat, drain, rinse with cold water to stop the cooking, and set it aside to cool.

Heat a grill pan or cast-iron skillet over high heat. Place the red pepper on the hot pan and cook until it is blackened on all sides, 8-12 minutes. Once the pepper is blackened, remove it from the heat and place it in a bowl with a tight-fitting lid to steam. After 5 minutes, scrape the black skin off of the pepper, discard the seeds and stem and dice the pepper.

In a large bowl, combine the drained pasta and the prepared dressing (see below) and mix them together. Add the diced red pepper, red onion, olives, artichoke hearts, pepperoncini, salami, and parsley. Mix to combine and top with the Parmesan cheese. Store in the refrigerator for 2 hours before serving to allow the flavors to marinate.

For the dressing

Using an immersion blender or food processor, combine the olive oil, red wine vinegar, balsamic vinegar, shallot, garlic, kosher salt, black pepper, red pepper flakes, Dijon mustard, oregano leaves, and basil leaves. Blend until the herbs are finely chopped and set it aside.

SHEET PAN BBQ CHICKEN AND VEGETABLES

Ingredients

1.5 lb chicken breast

4 cups sweet potatoes, peeled, raw, diced (about 2 medium to large sweet potatoes)

2 cups red onion, diced

1 lb broccolini, or broccoli

1 tsp olive oil

2 tbsp BBQ sauce

1 tbsp honey

Spice Rub

1 tsp paprika

1 tsp onion powder

1 tsp garlic powder

1 tsp coriander

1 tsp kosher salt

1 tsp brown sugar

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 425F.

Peel and dice the sweet potatoes.

Line a sheet pan with foil or parchment paper. Spray the foil or parchment paper with olive oil.

Combine the spice mixture ingredients.

Toss the sweet potato in a bowl with the olive oil. Add 1 tbsp of the spice mixture (reserve the rest for the chicken later). Toss to combine, and then pour the sweet potatoes onto the sheet pan.

Add more olive oil spray on top and roast the sweet potatoes for 15 minutes.

While the sweet potatoes are cooking, dice the red onion, trim and wash the broccolini, and cut the chicken breast into 8 pieces. Season the chicken breast with the remaining spice rub; use your hands to massage the rub into the chicken.

After the sweet potatoes have cooked for 15 minutes, remove the sheet pan from the oven. Move the sweet potatoes over to one side of the sheetpan.

Add more olive oil spray to the sheet pan, then add the onion, broccolini, and seasoned chicken to the sheet pan.

Spray olive oil spray on all of the vegetables. Add a pinch of salt to the broccolini and the onions.

Roast for another 15 minutes.

Combine the BBQ sauce with the honey in a small bowl.

Remove the sheet pan from the oven again. Brush the BBQ sauce and honey mixture onto the chicken.

Toss the vegetables. Return the sheet pan to the oven for another 10 minutes.




